35mm Reflex Camera with Motor Drive and Two Exposure Modes

Lens:

- "MC Zenitar-K-2" 50mm f/2.0

Mounting Type:

- K-type bayonet mount (PENTAX)

Focusing:

- manual

Exposure Metering:

- with TTL system, integral with LED indication in the viewfinder device
- exposure memory

Exposure Control:

- 2 modes: manual and automatic with aperture priority
- focal blade metal shutter with vertical movements of blades

Shutter Speeds Range:

- in automatic mode from 16 up to 1/2000s
- in manual mode from 1 up to 1/2000s, B
- synchronization with flash unit at 1/125s
- electronic self-timer with 15s delay

Viewfinder:

- displays 92% of the frame area
- focusing screen of matte field split-image type, with microprism ring

Film Sensitivity Input:

- automatic with DX-coding (ISO 50-3200)



Other Features:

- automatic loading, transporting and rewinding the film
- date overprinting device
- serial taking and taking per frame with the speed of 2 frames/s within range from 1/30 up to 1/2000s
- electronic frame counter
- flange base of 45.5mm
- tripod screw bush
